  - good vs. bad


Who are the characters?

- person or animal in the story
- protagonist: main character, good or heroic type
- antagonist: person or force that works against the hero
- place and time the story takes place

- action that makes up the story

# EQ. What are literary devices? (part 1)

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literary device	specific language techniques an author uses
Hyperbole	exaggerated language, to the extreme (Ex: I am so hungry I could eat a horse!)
Alliteration	repetition of beginning consonant sounds (Ex: deep, dark dungeon)
Allusion	reference to a well known person or place (Ex: Hot as Hades)
Onomatopoeia	word whose sound makes you think of its meaning (Ex: buzz, pow)
Simile	comparing 2 things using "like" or "as".
Metaphor	Compares 2 things without a comparison word ("is")
Personification	giving life-like characteristics to non-living things
